#### WHAT:

##### **What is Executive Women International's purpose?**

- Promoting member firms
- Networking
- Enhancing personal and professional development
- Encouraging community involvement

##### **What do members do to achieve those purposes?**

- Exchange ideas with other professionals.
- Attend programs designed to create an awareness of current business and civic concerns.
- Your firm will make many valuable contacts in the community and build stronger business relationships.
- Your representative(s) will have many opportunities for professional growth through attendance at monthly meetings, seminars and workshops at EWI's Leadership Conference & Annual Meeting and the EWI Academy of Leadership. Additional skill sets can be learned through participation in Chapter committees and board positions.

##### **What are other unique details of EWI membership?**

- The membership belongs to the firm rather than the representative.
- An individual in a key position with the firm is the active representative.
- Both women and men are invited to act as representatives for member firms.
- Membership is by invitation only and is comprised of diverse, non-competitive businesses or associations.
- The individual representing a member firm is EWI is one who is in a leading executive, administrative or executive secretarial position.

## **What are requirements of membership?**

### **Admission Fee:**

New Firms (one-time fee) \$50.00

*(The admission fee is never part of your renewal dues. Once you have joined the chapter, this fee covers all processing in the local chapter as well as the corporate office.)*

### **Annual Assessments:**

Omaha Chapter Dues	\$100
Convenience Fee (Credit Card Payment)	\$10 (if used)

## **What do you pay after your initial year in EWI?**

The annual renewal assessment will be \$255 for a firm with one representative.

## **What is the cost to attend monthly meetings?**

Monthly meeting cost is \$30 per person (except for Executives' Night and the ASIST Banquet). This cost covers meal, speaker and incidentals for the evening. Most firms pay this expense for their representative(s).

## **WHERE:**

### **Where are meetings held?**

Monthly Omaha chapter meetings are held at various locations in the Omaha metro area. Date, time and location are sent to all representatives in the monthly newsletter.

## **WHEN:**

### **When are chapter meetings held?**

The 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday evening of each month with the exception of November and December when the meeting is held on a date predetermined by the Board. Because of the holidays, these are usually earlier within the month. Meetings begin at 5:30 p.m. (networking time), 6:00 p.m. (dinner) followed by a program or business meeting.

### **When can firms attend a meeting?**

- Posted firms can attend one meeting as our guest – free of charge.
- Unposted firms can attend one meeting at their own expense.

- As soon as an application is submitted and the membership fee is paid, firms are welcome to attend all chapter meetings.
